Call for applications: Erasmus Plus scholarships to study at the University of Danish School of Media Journalism (DMJX)* during the spring semester of 2017-2018

The European Union is offering 3 scholarships for Bachelor's students to study at DMJX within the Erasmus Plus Program. Detailed information is available in the table below.

Language of Instruction	Danish, English
Requirements	A. Registered student at TAU B. Minimum average of 80 C. Fluent English or Danish– the minimum required English level is B2. D. Bachelor's level students from the following fields: media, journalism, media production, management. Students can only participate in the program from the 1st semester of the second year of studies until the 1st semester of the last year of studies.
Scholarship details	4.250 Euro for a duration of 5 months (850 EUR per month). - Travel expenses on the amount of 530 EUR.
Number of required credits	Students are required to take at least 30 ECTS credits (equivalent to 15 TAU credits) in order to be eligible for the Erasmus Plus Scholarship. * Deviations may be possible, pending approval from DMJX. University

It is under the student responsibility to insure himself/herself for the whole duration of stay Students are required to submit a proof of insurance to the office of international academic affairs at TAU prior to their mobility period.

* Travel grant and scholarship will be offered only should the two institutions sign an agreement regarding academic cooperation under the Erasmus Plus Program.



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
